## How to create a video for Welsh Charities Week

Whether you work or volunteer with a charitable organisation, there are plenty of ways to get involved in Welsh Charities Week – including sharing a video on social media about your charity or organisation.

Using your smartphone or webcam record a video telling everyone about who you are and what you do.

Tell everyone about your charity and the work you do to make a difference. Your video should be **no longer than about two minutes** in length and should cover the following:

-  **Welsh Charities Week** – Don't forget to mention 'it's Welsh Charities Week' or that you're recording this for Welsh Charities Week
-  **Who are you?** – What is the name of your organisation? Where are you based?
-  **What do you do?** – How do you help people, the community or support your service users?
-  **Why do you want to shout about it?** – What are you most proud of?
